
3 Days & 3 Nights Timeline



- 1. Jesus eats the Passover (sometime after 6 PM) Exodus 12:6; Matthew 26:17-25; Mark 14:12-25; Luke 22:7-28; John 13 During this night, Jesus prays in the Garden of Gethsemane and is betrayed by Judas Iscariot
- 2. The trial before Pilate (around 6 AM) Matthew 27:11-14; Mark 15:2-5; Luke 23:1-5; John 18:28-37
- 3. Jesus is crucified (9 AM) Matthew 27:34-56; Mark 15:15-32 (25); Luke 23:27-49; John 19:13-37 (14) John's audience is Gentile 6th hour=6:00 AM
- 4. Three hours of darkness (12 PM-3 PM) Matthew 27:45; Mark 15:33; Luke 23:44
- 5. Jesus dies (3 PM) Matthew 27:46-50; Mark 15:34-37; Luke 23:46; John 19:30
- 6. Jesus' body is buried (just before 6 PM) Matthew 27:57-61; Mark 15:42-47; Luke 23:50-54; John 19:38-42
- 7. Women bought spices (between the two Sabbaths) Mark 16:1; Luke 23:54-56;
- 8. Jesus is resurrected (around 6PM) exactly 72 hours in the tomb Matthew 28:2 (possible digression in Matthew's account telling of the moment)
- 9. The women visit the tomb at sunrise (between 3 & 6 AM) Matthew 28:1-6; Mark 16:1-7; Luke 24:1-8
- 10. Jesus visits men on the road to Emmaus sometime before 6 PM Sunday. Three days **since** the burial of Jesus. Luke 24:13
